FAMILY DETAILS Frederick was born In Down Street, North Warnborough on 7th May 1892^{xlvi} to George Woolford, a cow keeper at the time, and Annie Woolford^{xlvii}. He was the eighth and youngest child of the family. He attended the London Road Board School from 1st March 1899^{xlviii}. In 1911 Frederick was living at 191 Manor Road, Itchen, with his sister, Mabel Knight, and her family and was employed as a 'fireman on a steam crane'^{xlix}.
