DEATH	In what became his obituary in the Hants & Berks Gazette of 20 October 1917 it was reported that on 26 th September 1916 Arthur 'was seriously wounded and further news is anxiously awaited by his parents'. This later was given as the day that he was killed in action.
FAMILY DETAILS	Arthur Binstead was born on 17 February 1894 in Odiham ¹³ . He was the third child of Walter, a grocer's manager, and Sarah Binstead of Church Street, Odiham. He had an older brother and sister. He started at Buryfields Infants School in 1897 ¹⁴ and went on to the London Road Board School on 1 March 1901 ¹⁵ . In 1911 he was working as a baker's journeyman ¹⁶ .
