DATE OF DEATH	17 August 1917 (age 26)
BATTLE	1917 Battles of Ypres (Third Ypres)
REGIMENT	1 st Battalion, Border Regiment
DEATH	In 1917 Albert was promoted to Lance Sergeant with effect from 25 May. Three months later he was wounded in action and died of these abdominal wounds shortly afterwards on 17 August 1917 ⁷⁰ .
FAMILY DETAILS	Albert Moody was born in Odiham on 6 th October 1890. He was the third son of Charles, a tinsmith, and Ellen Moody, who lived at Chapel Pond, North Warnborough ⁷¹ . Five of the seven brothers fought in the War, the remaining two being too young to serve with the colours.
