FAMILY DETAILS

Ambrose Offer was the son of Mrs Alfred (Keturah) Keel and the late George Offer. He was born in 1891 in Uphill, Urchfont, Wiltshire, where his father was a carter on a local farm^{xxi}. George Offer died a year later, aged 39^{xxii}. In 1897, Ambrose's mother, Keturah, married Alfred Keel in Wiltshire^{xxiii}, and by 1901 the family had moved to Cemetery Hill, Odiham^{xxiv}. In 1911 Ambrose was employed as a 'Motor and cycle repairer' and lived with his mother and stepfather in King Street^{xxv}.
