DEATH	Killed in action Charles was an early casualty of the campaign, being killed in action just three days after landing at Cape Helles in the Dardanelles
FAMILY DETAILS	Charles was the youngest son of John and Ann Fulbrook of Broad Oak⁶¹. In 1911 he had been an errand boy in an oil stores⁶², living at home with his parents, his older brothers, Frank and Frederick, both farm labourers like their father, and his older sister, Britannia, who was 'helping at home'.
