FAMILY DETAILS Arthur was the fourth son of Stephen, an agriculture labourer, and Sophia Pither of North Warnborough. He was born on 29 March 1884^{xxxi} and attended London Road Board School from April 1891 until March 1897^{xxxii}. He had worked for the late Mr A J Parsons, Odiham, for eleven years, and also for the late Mr Gower of Hook. In 1911 his occupation on the census was recorded as 'Carman Iron Foundry'^{xxxiii}. Arthur left for Canada on 12 March 1913 from Liverpool.
