FAMILY DETAILS	Frank was born in Marchwood, Hampshire in 1881, the son of Police Constable William Butler and his wife Sarah. By 1891 the family had moved to the police station at New Alresford, where William Butler was a Police Sergeant³⁴. By 1901, Frank's mother was a widow working as a charwoman and living in The Bury in Odiham. In 1908 Frank married Kate Annie Trowbridge in Hartley Wintney Registration District³⁵. In 1911 the couple were living in Bellwood Cottage, Hartley Wintney with their daughter, Ivy Muriel, aged 1 year. Frank was working as a domestic gardener³⁶. His mother, Sarah, still lived in The Bury, Odiham, but was now a laundress³⁷.
