



COMPANY SERJEANT MAJOR WALTER JAMES FULBROOK

DATE OF DEATH	3 November 1916 (aged 26)
BATTLE	Left England for India in 1914 and entered Asiatic theatre of war in Basra in March 1915. He then rose from Private to Company Serjeant Major before his death
REGIMENT	1 st /4 th Bn., Hampshire Regiment
DEATH	Died of pneumonia
FAMILY DETAILS	Born in Broad Oak in 1890 and lived there with his grandparents, Jonathon and Jane Fulbrook. Civilian occupation – bootmaker. After arrival in Basra in March 1915 he rose from Private to Company Serjeant Major.
MEMORIAL	Buried in Amara War Cemetery, Iraq
